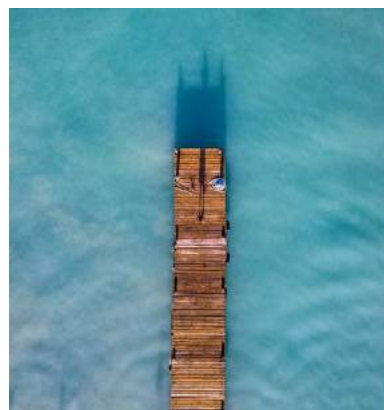

General overview of subjects.

During the 12-week lecture phase the following subjects will be taught:

- Biblical Worldview of Family,
- Family of Origin Model,
- Genogram
- Marriage Relationship,
- Parenting,
- Basic Seminar Skills (for 1-2 hour seminars),
- Christian Family Lifestyle,
- Skills for Helping Families,
- Family Ministering Together,
- Biblical Application of Finances.

Besides these subjects there will be one-on ones, small groups, books to read and a Marriage Course to follow.

Community living.

During the school, staff and students will be living together in community. We will have worship and intercession together. We will have work duties together and we will play games and eat together. There will however also be time for your own family unit. We aim to accommodate all staff and students, including families, in a safe and spacious location.

Aruba.

Aruba is a beautiful island in the Caribbean Sea, located close to Venezuela. It is 21 miles (33 km) long and 6 miles (9km) wide. It is mainly flat with a few hills and is known for its white sandy beaches. With a constant temperature of 83°F (28°C) and an ever-present cooling wind Aruba is a very attractive place to be.

YWAM Aruba is a pioneering base. Since two years we have a more permanent presence on the island and the FMS/FFS is the very first school that we organize. Fortunately, we found very experienced school leaders who have been involved in various YWAM school all over the world, from New Zealand to South Africa, to Kona.
