When we look back on the year 2024, we think of the start of the La Sala project. La Sala means living room in Spanish, and with this project we pursue a safe place for women who work in prostitution. Although we don't have a living room where we can bring this safe place into reality yet, we have seen God's goodness in the weekly coffee afternoons that we were able to organize for these women.

Every year, more than 350 women from Spanish speaking countries in the Caribbean travel to Aruba to work for three months in prostitution in Aruba. Most of these women are connected to their families. In fact, their families are often the reason for them to come to Aruba. Many of these women believe in God. And even though this is the case, they somehow they don't see any other option than to make the choice to come to Aruba and work in prostitution.

God gave us a deep love for these women. It is a holy love that only can come from God. We often ask ourselves what would happen if these women would have a real understanding of their Father in heaven and what effect that would have on their self-image and their families. We are regularly praying to see glimpses of the change that a real understanding of who God is can bring into the lives of these women. We strongly believe that He also wants healthy and strong families for them. That is why we know this ministry fits the mission God gave us.

It is our mission to help restore God's love in families, and in 2024 we saw God's faithfulness displayed throughout the different ministries. What a blessing to see the ministries grow and be fruitful. We realize that this could not have happened without the permanent ongoing stream of prayers, encouragements, and support of all our mission partners. Erik went to Tanzania for 2 weeks of trauma counseling, a family ministry conference and teaching.







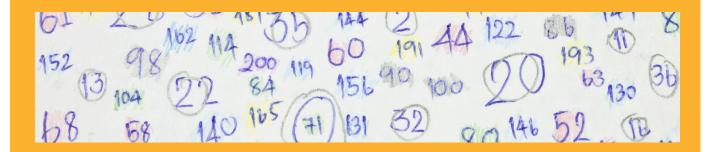
La Sala

During this meeting the women were presented the gospel in an easy way and it was received well. These women, who were far away from home during the holiday season, were treated with a wonderful meal in a home like setting in a safe environment. Many of them were touched by the love of God through our volunteers.

Notes to the balances sheet

GENERAL

The foundation was established in 2009 and is located on Aruba, registered at the Chamber of Commerce under case number S1099.0 with the registered name: "Youth With a Mission A-B-C".

As of July 27, 2021 the Foundation is recognized as an ANBI by the Dutch Tax Authorities.

The Youth With A Mission A-B-C Foundation (YWAM Aruba) is an active non-profit organization in Aruba. This foundation has the objective to work within the community on a future that offers perspective for strong and healthy families. There are many broken families in Aruba, with negative consequences for the Arubian society. With a long-term presence within the community, this organization makes a structural contribution towards building strong and healthy families in Aruba. The YWAM Aruba foundation is financially supported by donors in various countries, including the Netherlands and the United States of America.

FIXED ASSETS

As per October 1, 2021 a Hyundai Van was purchased. AWG 10.107 of the purchase amount was directly paid for by the Foundation. The remaining AWG was directly paid from the Netherlands. The depreciation term is 5 years, starting at October 1, 2021. As the van is owned by the foundation, the value of the van as at purchase date was fully recognized as income for the foundation. The purchase price of the van was AWG 33.750. As per December 2022 a trailer was purchased for AWG 7.700. During 2023 a potable speaker was purchased for AWG 355. The depreciation term for all assets is 5 years.

Cash at Bank regard the balance held with RBC Royal Bank (Aruba) N.V. Receivables regard the donations in December from YWAM Netherlands, received in 2025.

The 'Reserve Assets' regard the value of the accumulated depreciation of fixed assets, to allocate reserves for the purpose of replacing existing assets in future. In case the income for the year does not cover the depreciation, shortage in a year could be replenished from 'Other Reserves'.

As the income and expenditures are rated on an average rate with differs from the exchange rate at balance sheet, the difference resulting from these exchange rates are accounted for under an 'Exchange Reserve'.

Note: the exchange rate of AWG to EUR as at December 31, 2024 applied was 1,9491 (2023: 1,9492). The EUR/USD exchange rate at December 31, 2024 was applied at 1,035 (2023: 1,1038).

Notes to statement of income and expenditures

INCOME

All donations that can be recognized as specific donations are labeled as such. If donations exceed the expenses for the year the remaining income is allocated to specific reserves ('Ministries', 'Training', or 'Building').

EXPENDITURES

During 2024 and 2023 no rent for office was applied.

Depreciation regard the van, trailer, and portable speaker. The depreciation period of all assets is 5 years. As the trailer was purchased in December 2022, no depreciation was applicable in 2022.

Costs of use of the van mainly comprises costs of insurance premiums, taxes and costs of fuel if not allocated to projects of Training or Ministries. Office costs regard cost for the website, phone costs and costs of printing ink. During 2023 no maintenance cost was applicable.

Note: the average rate 2024 of AWG to EUR applied was 1,9492 (2023: 1,9492) and for EUR/USD average rate applied was 1,0822 (2023: 1,0825).
