OUR SERVICE

What we already do

Most of all we try to establish a relationship with the women. Every three months there is a new group which makes this a continuous attempt. We visit them in their working environment and provide them with food packages and hygiene products. We encourage and support them to overcome challenges and to make positive lasting changes in their lives, for their own benefit and that of their families and home communities. We do this by organizing fun activities where they can come together to spend a relaxed moment and quality time. They are offered the opportunity to vent their hearts and, if they wish, we pray with them.




What we want to do

The way we want to shape our mission is through a living room, La Sala, for the women who work in the sex industry in San Nicolas. It will be a place where they can meet others, and feel at home, loved, cared for, seen, safe and accepted as part of the community. A place where they can get coffee, do arts and crafts, and get help and information. We want to offer them prayer, Bible study and various other fun activities and interesting and helpful classes.







OUR SERVICES

What we want to do

We intend to open up La Sala from Monday to Friday. During these hours, we will work with volunteers who offer a friendly face and a listening ear. If the women have questions, we can pass on information about healthcare, rights and we intend to also have a variety of products like condoms and female hygiene products available. For this we want to work with different organizations such as CMMA, Rode Kruis, IOM, Hias and others.

During the morning hours we also want to offer extra activities that the women can join if they want to. Bible studies, arts and crafts, counseling, game-mornings and practical short courses on topics such as How to start your own business, English, Parenting, Budgeting etc. On Monday and Tuesday we also want to offer walk-in opportunities with a general practitioner and an advisor from Dimas.


